The Black Ribbon Commemoration in Ottawa is part of a National Day of Remembrance in Canada to mark the anniversary of the infamous 1939 Molotov-Ribbentrop Pact between the Soviet Union and Nazi Germany that directly led to the occupation of most of Central and Eastern Europe, Finland and the Baltic States, and the slaughter and oppression of tens of millions.

Coordination is by the Central and Eastern European Council in Canada in collaboration with the Albanian, Belarusian, Czech, Estonian, Hungarian, Latvian, Lithuanian, Polish, Slovak and Ukrainian communities.

This commemoration remembers the men, women and children in many parts of the world who continue to face violence and repression from totalitarian regimes and dehumanizing ideologies.
